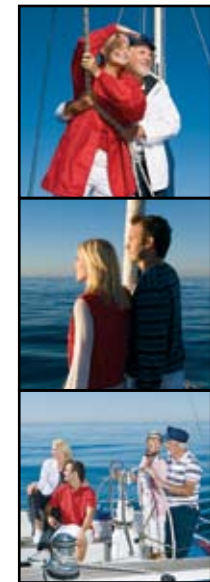

What is Ancillary Coverage?

Contemporary yachts and their systems are becoming increasingly sophisticated as we take the comforts of home to sea. The additional cost to equip a modern vessel with all the latest navigation, communication and computer equipment can represent many tens of thousands of dollars. Not to mention dinghies, dive gear, personal watercrafts, submersibles and motorbikes. These "toys" will usually be considered as Ancillary items and represent a possible liability to the yacht owner should a guest become injured while operating them.



Also critical is that your crew be identified and covered. Most policies exclude an owner's liability to a paid crew member unless specifically indicated in the policy. Various federal acts provide an avenue of compensation for paid crew should they suffer injury or illness while employed in the service of your vessel.

These are just a few situations that must be identified by your insurance broker. The broker should have multiple insurance markets with whom to place coverage competitively.
